VALLEY AND CONDITIONS

Origin: El Boldo, Villa Alegre, Mariposas

Soil: Alluvial and colluvial.

Climate: Mediterranean with extended dry season

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Color: Brilliant, with an intense red purple

Nose: Complex. With notes of fresh fruits such as strawberry, plum, blackberry and delicate spices aromas.

Palate: With character, elegant tannins and persistent finish

The character and potency of the Cabernet Sauvignon from Cauquenes (D.O. Maule) is the foundation of the blend. A small percentage of Syrah contributes black fruit and rich acidity, and the Merlot delivers softness and freshness.
